

Glorieta Conference Center Standards

The Glorieta Conference Center is a Christian conference center. In keeping with our mission, the following standards help to assure the comfort of our guests and employees:

- On campus use of alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, tobacco, firearms and fireworks is prohibited. Violations of this rule will result in immediate dismissal. Arriving on campus in possession of or under the influence of illegal drugs or alcohol will be considered the same as on-campus use.
- A basic guide for dress is to “maintain a neat, clean appearance with no extremes.” Immodest clothing, distasteful monograms, bare feet in public areas, or any extreme style of dress is prohibited. Shirt tails should be tucked in and shirts buttoned. Examples of unacceptable clothing include patched, frayed or faded garments, tank tops, midriffs, halter-type tops, T-shirts with questionable sayings or logos. Hair must be clean and well groomed. Males are not allowed to wear ear rings.
- Pets are not permitted in any Glorieta facility including barn/tack/office areas.
- Glorieta observes a curfew of 11:30 p.m. for all guests and campus residents. If off campus past 11:30 p.m., please go directly for your room upon returning to the campus. Any disturbance or unnecessary noise created by late arrivals will not be tolerated.
- Observe and obey the 20 MPH speed limit, obey all traffic signs and remember pedestrians have the right of way on all streets on campus.
- Your conduct and appearance anywhere on campus must not be offensive to our guests or in any way detrimental to the ministry of the Glorieta Conference Center. This includes dress, appearance, speech, promiscuity, and/or questionable activity.
