Requirements For Packing For a Drop Camp

- 1. One hundred fifty (150) pounds maximum weight per pack horse.
- 2. Kitchen equipment and food will be packed in cardboard boxes measuring 11" in width, 11" high, and 16" in length. Citrus fruit boxes (Orange, Lemon, Grapefruit) will work well.
 - 2a. two boxes per horse.
- 3. Coolers will be no bigger than 24" in length, and 14" wide (48 quart).
 - 3a. two coolers per horse.
 - 3b. coolers must not exceed 50 pounds per cooler.
 - 3c. coolers must be paired and matching in weight.
- 4. Pack personal gear in duffel bags, 21" X 36" military type work best. **Duffel bags must not exceed 30 pounds per duffel bag.**
 - 3a. Three (3) duffel bags per horse.
- 5. Boxes and duffel bags need to be weighed and marked. Boxes need to be paired.
- 6. Tent poles, fishing rods, bow cases, shovels, axes, or any equipment of this type must not exceed forty (40) inches.
- 7. Bedrolls, backpacks and daypacks cannot be carried on saddle horse. They must be carried on pack horses.
